The 'Live Better for Less' project is focused around a free one-day indoor community event featuring 30-35 stands providing advice and information on all aspects of spending less money on essentials. This includes, for example, information on household budgeting and financial advice, growing your own fruit and veg, freecycle, budget cookery, car share/cycling, energy saving, thrifty shopping tips, cheap or free entertainment and exercise/sport activities. For the kids there will be free basketball and hip-hop workshops on the day plus a variety of entertainment. Entry to the event, plus all workshops and demonstrations will be entirely free. Live Better for Less will be held from 10-4pm on Saturday 15th November at Community Wise community centre.
